Description: The 45North Coordinator builds, oversees the implementation of, and promotes 45North, ZoeCare's education arm according to the direction of the Community Engagement Director.

Reports To: Community Engagement Director

Supervises: 45North Presenters, Teachers and 45North Community Volunteers

Weekly Hours: 16 (up to 20 as necessary)

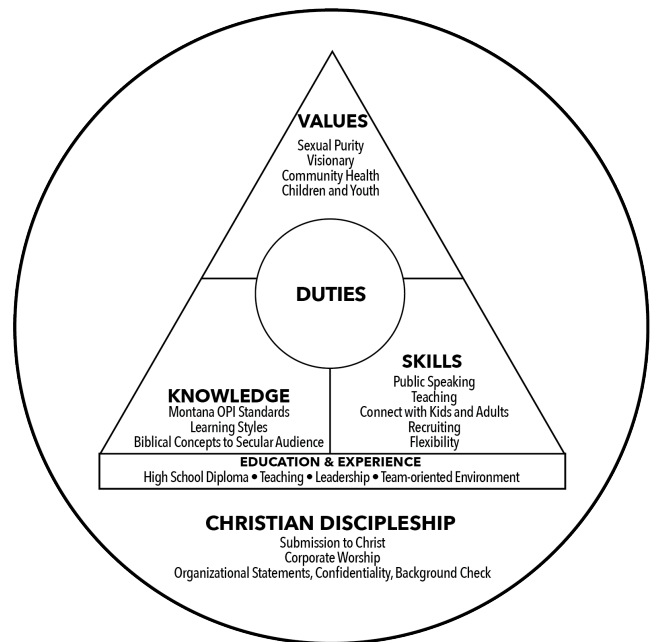
Strategic Importance: The 45North Coordinator directly oversees the preventative piece of ZoeCare's community strategy by educating youth, parents, and young adults about responsible, godly sexual health. The work of the 45North Coordinator is central to ZoeCare's community transformation.

Christian Discipleship: These core characteristics are required for all employees and volunteers.

- Submit to Christ's leadership and guidance.
- Participate in corporate worship at a local Christian church.
- Agree with ZoeCare's *Organizational Statements*, comply with and sign the ZoeCare confidentiality statement, and document completion of a Montana criminal background check.

Duties:

- Present or oversee the presenting of the 45North curricula up to five classes per day during presentations.
- Recruit, train and oversee 45North Presenters and Teachers.
- Assist the Community Engagement Director in researching, developing and updating 45North curricula as needed for all applicable audiences.
- Pursue and establish presenting opportunities in schools, churches and other relevant venues in the community, and communicate with administrators and teachers in a timely and professional manner regarding expectations and scheduling.
- Pursue and establish new venues and explore new methods in which to present 45North's message of holistic relationship training and sexual health.



CORE COMPETENCIES: 45North Coordinator

- Follow up with teachers, administrators and church leaders after presentations with student feedback.
- Work to complete specified 45North goals and objectives.
- Resolve any issues and solve problems in the 45North program as they arise.
- Track and report on project milestones and provide status reports to Community Engagement Director.
- Determine how results will be measured and complete a post-project evaluation. Be accountable to Community Engagement Director for project results.
- Develop tools and best practices for project management and execution.
- Other duties as assigned.

Knowledge:

- Montana OPI standards for sexual education. (Not a prerequisite)
- Different learning styles and accommodating teaching for each.
- How to apply biblical concepts to a secular audience.

Skills:

- Excellent public speaking with clear, compelling communication.
- Teaching especially rowdy kids about sensitive topics.
- Ability to relationally connect with both kids and adults.
- Ability to recruit and inspire others to follow a vision.
- Flexibility; ability to manage multiple projects going at the same time, sometimes at inconvenient times of the day and week.

- Sexual purity.
- Visionary.
- Community health.
- Children and youth.

Education & Experience:

- High school diploma.
- Preferred teaching or nursing experience (a teaching certificate or RN license is not required but helpful).
- Successful experience in a leadership position and managing others.
