

## Community Educator

**Purpose:** To present a biblical, holistic approach to sexual health, body literacy, pregnancy support, and relationships to youth and adults.

**Description:** Community Educators teach about healthy relationships and the importance of avoiding sexual risks, body literacy and cycle tracking, and how to support pregnant women and their partners using a variety of curricula and interactive lessons in schools, churches, and other community venues.

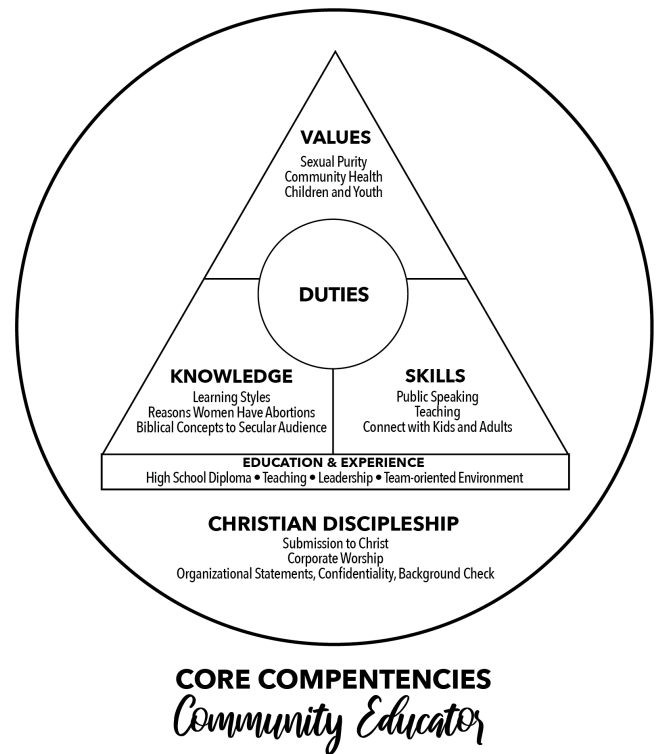
**Reports To:** Education Director

**Weekly Hours:** 5-10 (periodically)

**Strategic Importance:** Community Educators are sent into the community by ZoeCare to stimulate positive transformation in the lives of youth and adults.

**Christian Discipleship:** These core characteristics are required for all employees and volunteers.

- Submit to Christ's leadership and guidance.
- Participate in corporate worship at a local Christian church.
- Agree with ZoeCare's *Organizational Statements*, conform to and sign the ZoeCare confidentiality statement, and document completion of a Montana criminal background check.



### Duties:

- Teach between one and five classes per day during school presentations.
- Follow 45North curricula to provide medically accurate and science-based information in an easy-to-understand, engaging way.
- Understand 45North topics to teach effectively in a variety of venues.
- Teach or facilitate church or community seminars on healthy relationships, body literacy, sex education, and related topics, as needed.
- Enforce applicable rules and standards of presentation venue.
- Assist with training new 45North Presenters, as needed.
- Commute within a 45-mile radius of ZoeCare's office (mileage reimbursement available).
- Provide regular feedback to Education Coordinator.
- Other duties as assigned.

### Knowledge:

- Different learning styles and accommodating teaching for each.

- How to apply biblical concepts to a secular audience.

**Skills:**

- Confident public speaking with clear, compelling communication.
- Teaching in a classroom setting.
- Ability to relationally connect with both kids and adults.

- Teaching experience is helpful (but not required).
- Basic medical knowledge is helpful (but not required).
