Hope in the midst of hardship by Chris K. Grinnell, Executive Director

n the last night before his crucifixion, Jesus told his lisciples, "In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world!" (John 16:33) In times of trouble and hardship, like the merciless COVID-19 pandemic, we are reminded that it is only by Jesus that we can overcome. He is our hope, the anchor for our souls. We can all accomplish amazing things and bring hope, even in the midst of hardship like a pandemic, because Jesus goes before us.

Here is what Jesus has done during the past year, despite the fear, unrest, and struggles that this country has faced.

Although ZoeCare provides many supportive programs for women and men to help them in their journey toward abundant life, our primary mandate is to save lives. Over the past year, 59 lives were directly saved from abortion because Jesus overcame through ZoeCare! About 87% of all of our pregnancy patients chose life for their child!

But those who wait on the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint. - Isaiah 40:31

Patients and their partners share many reasons why they feel abortion is their only choice. Finances, schooling, life opportunities, broken relationships, and housing are often cited. We can't solve all of their hardships for them, but our mentoring programs go a long way to equip them to face life's challenges head on. This past year, though significantly interrupted by the pandemic, we had more than 30 men and women in our two mentoring programs, being DAD and Mom2Mom. Additionally, over 60 moms have received free diapers through our Sweet Cheeks program since its kick-off in January.

The COVID-19 pandemic compounds the struggles that young families face. To offer some relief to those in our community hit the hardest, ZoeCare held our first Diaper Day in June, in which we distributed nearly 10,000 diapers to 82 struggling families.

In January, we finalized 45North's curriculum for relationship training and sexual education presentations to middle schoolers. That enables ZoeCare considerable freedom in sharing about sex and relationships, as well as how it is presented. We will be ready next spring to present to six schools in the area, the most we have ever had lined up.
