

JULIA'S BRAVE CHOICE FOR LIFE

The names and some minor details of the following story have been changed to protect the identities of those involved.

When we first met Julia she was in a four-year stable relationship with Robert. They both worked in the construction industry. Julia already had one daughter from a previous relationship. They came into ZoeCare to confirm the viability of their pregnancy. As they talked separately with patient and partner advocates, they verbalized their intent to continue the pregnancy even though it was unexpected. Due to the early nature of the pregnancy, an ultrasound was not performed. We gave community support and provider referrals to them both. When Julia was discharged, she was looking forward to her appointment with the OB provider.

On a weekend two months later, Julia reached out to the on-call nurse and gave an update to her situation. She shared that she and Robert recently broke up and now she felt under enormous financial pressure. As a result, she was strongly considering abortion. Julia made an appointment with ZoeCare for a few days later. During that appointment, Julia was very open with the nurse and patient advocate about her situation and all of the stress she was feeling. She requested information about abortion. The nurse provided Julia with evidence-based literature for her to review concerning her options in depth as well as information on fetal development and other related topics. Together, the patient advocate and Julia worked through a decision guide that facilitated Julia in understanding her thoughts on the options before her. She also evaluated and rated the importance of each benefit and risk of each option. Because Julia shared that she has a faith

background and that abortion is contrary to those beliefs, the nurse encouraged her to read her Bible during this time of uncertainty and they read portions of Psalm 139 together.

During the course of the discussion, Julia mentioned that she had had a couple of ultrasounds since her first visit at ZoeCare and that she had not been able to see the baby during the procedure. She said she did not feel at all connected to the baby. During this visit, the nurse performed another ultrasound and Julia became teary eyed at what she saw on the screen: the sweet profile of her baby's face, the occasional wiggles and turning of her baby, and the rhythmic clapping of the baby's heart.

Julia left ZoeCare feeling connected to her preborn child and confessing that she is now planning on carrying this pregnancy to term despite the challenges!
